





Every year, we put out a new fabric collection. and it's always exciting to see how the new range works with our existing Skinny laMinx prints and colours.


In styling and photographing this Colour Book, we've enjoyed exploring some of the new ideas & possibilities opened up by our brand new range, DIGGI DOT...


